Ga Ting means "family" in Cantonese. The play weaves a powerful and emotionally-charged story about an immigrant Chinese couple trying to come to terms with the death of their son, Kevin. They invite Kevin's caucasian boyfriend for dinner after the funeral, and, for the first time, not only acknowledge that their son was gay, but who he truly was as a person. As the characters share memories of Kevin, feelings of sorrow, anger, guilt, and disappointment spill forth. Their dinner conversation eventually evolves into a fiery cultural and generational clash.
